4. Coinflip

A classic 1v1 video game of possibility. Two gamers wager skins of roughly equal worth. The system designates one player as Heads and the other as Tails, then flips a virtual coin. The winner takes the whole pot, minus a little platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the expert scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match wagering is the go-to alternative. Users wager on professional groups using odds determined by the platform, similar to conventional sportsbooks.
