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Documents to prepare

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Build a detailed inventory

International moves depend heavily on accurate inventories. Customs authorities often want a line-by-line list of what is being shipped, and movers use that inventory to track and clear goods at the destination.

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Your inventory should be detailed enough to identify each category of item, and it should note any valuables, electronics, or restricted goods. A clear inventory helps prevent delays and makes it easier to prove what is in the shipment if customs asks questions.

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Inventory best practices

- List items room by room.
- Describe boxes clearly instead of using vague labels.
- Record serial numbers for electronics.
- Separate restricted or questionable items before packing.

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Know what cannot travel

Most countries restrict certain items such as alcohol, flammables, perishables, plants, live animals, medicines, cleaning products, weapons, currency, and some electronics. That is why you should review prohibited and restricted items before the packing begins.

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Leaving out restricted items from the shipment protects you from customs problems later. It also helps the moving crew pack only what can be legally shipped and reduces the chance of inspection delays.

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Choose the right shipping method

International movers from Las Vegas often provide pickup, packing, transport to the port, customs documentation support, and delivery at the destination. Depending on the shipment size and destination, your belongings may travel by air or by ocean container.

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For many household moves, ocean shipping is the practical choice because it can handle larger volumes more efficiently.
