A classic 1v1 game of chance. Two players wager skins of approximately equivalent value. The system designates one player as Heads and the other as Tails, then flips a virtual coin. The winner takes the entire pot, minus a little platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the expert scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match wagering is the go-to choice. Users bet on expert groups using odds computed by the platform, comparable to conventional sportsbooks.
