⚙️ DIY TROUBLESHOOTING

1. CHECK THERMOSTAT



Verify settings, ensure power, replace batteries.



2. REPLACE AIR FILTER



Check monthly, change every 1-3 months.



3. CLEAR OUTDOOR UNIT



Remove debris, ensure 2ft clearance.



4. RESET CIRCUIT BREAKER



Look for tripped switch, reset once.



🔧 WHEN TO CALL A PRO

1. STRANGE NOISES



Grinding, squealing, or banging sounds.



2. NO COOL/HEAT



System runs but doesn't cool or heat.



3. LEAKING WATER



Excess moisture or pooling water around unit.



4. FREQUENT CYCLING



System turns on and off constantly.



VERDICT: Simple maintenance and filter changes are DIY. Complex issues, noises, or lack of performance require a professional technician.
