What should you do the moment you discover water damage in your home?

When you find water pooling on floors, seeping through walls, or dripping from ceilings, your immediate action is to stop the source if it's safe to do so. Locate your main water shut-off valve and turn it off—most homeowners don't know where it is until an emergency forces them to learn. If the water is coming from a burst pipe under your house, a failed water heater, or a toilet overflow, stopping the flow is your first and most critical step. Moisture begins migrating into drywall, insulation, subflooring, and structural framing within hours of exposure. Once water penetrates these porous materials, the cost to dry, restore, or replace them climbs steeply. If you wait a day or two, what started as a pipe burst affecting one room can become a multi-room drying project requiring industrial-grade equipment for weeks. Mold colonies can establish themselves in 24 to 48 hours in humid Colorado Springs conditions, adding remediation costs that dwarf the original water removal expense. 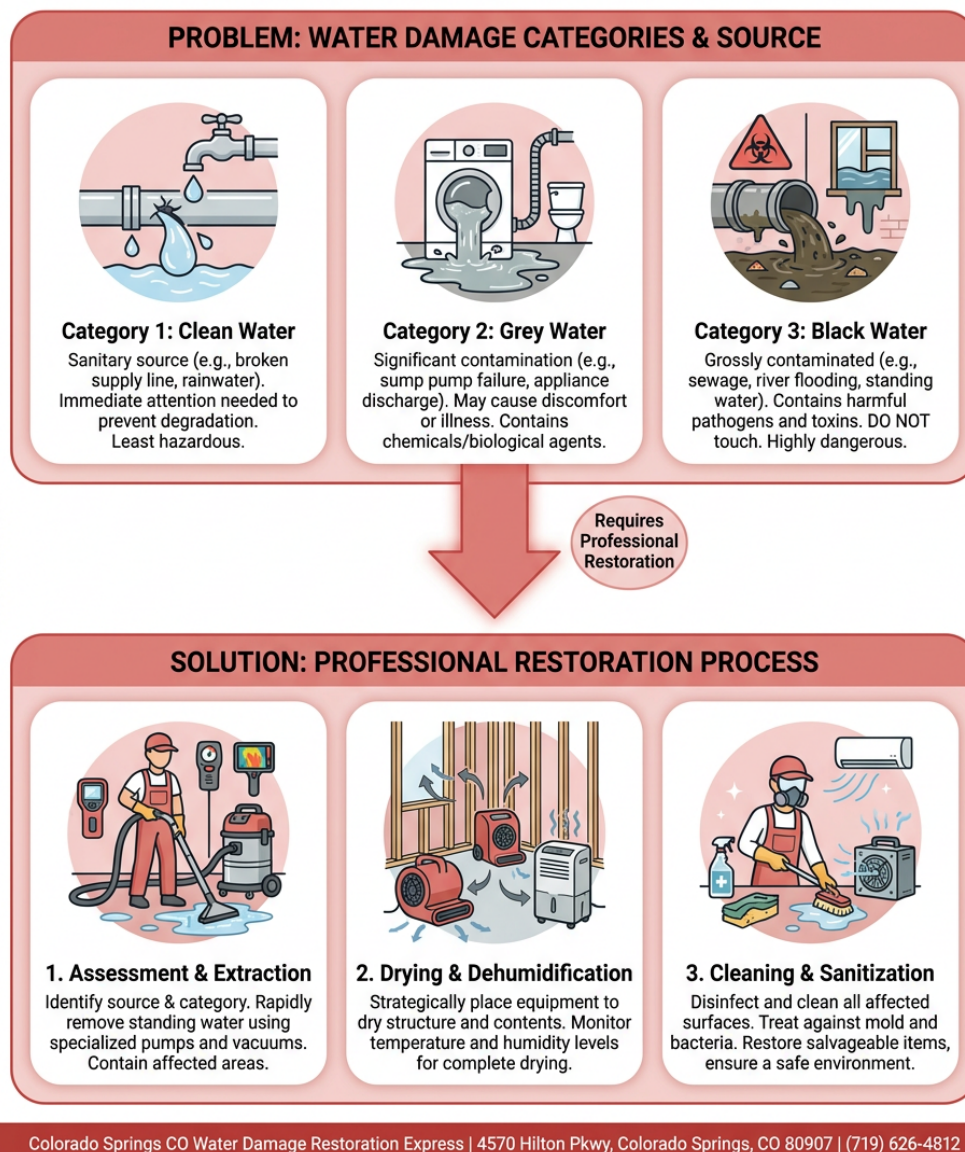
What should your first-call checklist include when contacting a restoration service?

Have these details ready when you call: the location of the damage, whether the water is still flowing, whether anyone is in danger, and whether you can safely access the affected area. Tell the dispatcher if the water came from a known source (burst pipe, roof leak, appliance failure) or an unknown source (foundation seepage, neighbor's damage). Mention if you have active homeowner's insurance and the policy number, though we handle uninsured damage too. Ask the service what time they can arrive and what you should do to prepare—usually we recommend turning off electricity to wet areas, removing valuable items if safe, and taking photos for your records.
