What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live dealer video game built around a massive, vertically installed 54-segment wheel. Hosted by an energetic, live presenter in a dynamic, Willy Wonka-esque studio, the game streams in real-time to players around the world.

Unlike conventional table video games like blackjack or live roulette, Crazy Time requires no complex memorization of guidelines or technique charts. Gamers simply put bets on where they think the wheel will stop, making it available to bitz.io outright novices while still offering the high volatility and enormous win potential that skilled bettors crave.

How the Game is Played

Every game round starts with a betting stage. Gamers have a minimal time to put their chips on one or more of the 8 available betting choices on the virtual layout. These alternatives consist of four numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) and four unique benefit games.

When wagering closes, the live host spins the huge wheel. Simultaneously, a different two-reel slot positioned above the main wheel-- referred to as the **Top Slot**-- spins alongside it.

The Top Slot Mechanism

Before the wheel stops, the Top Slot produces a random multiplier and appoints it to among the 8 wagering choices on the wheel.

- If the Top Slot multiplier and the wheel result line up on the very same sector, the multiplier uses to that win.
- If the result is a reward game, the multiplier enhances all the multipliers *inside* that specific benefit round, resulting in possibly astronomical payments.

Comprehending the Wheel Segments and Payouts

The 54 sectors on the Crazy Time wheel are distributed among numbers and reward video games. Naturally, the lower-paying numbers appear a lot more frequently on the wheel than the rare benefit rounds.

Breakdown of Wheel Segments

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times (Payout: 1:1)
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times (Payout: 2:1)
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times (Payout: 5:1)
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times (Payout: 10:1)
- **Coin Flip Bonus:** Appears 4 times
- **Cash Hunt Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Pachinko Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Crazy Time Bonus:** Appears 1 time

Dive Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The real magic-- and the source of the video game's biggest payments-- lies within its 4 interactive reward rounds. Whenever the wheel arrive at a bonus offer sector, players who positioned a bet on that specific feature are carried to a secondary video game screen.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the 4 perks, this round includes a coin with a red side and a blue side.

- Each side is assigned a random multiplier before the flip.
- The host presses a button to flip the coin, and whichever color lands face-up awards the matching multiplier to the player's bet.

2. Cash Hunt

This is a giant interactive shooting gallery featuring a screen with 108 random multipliers concealed behind numerous signs (like a cactus, target, or chef's hat).

- Players utilize a virtual crosshair to aim and shoot at a sign of their choice before a countdown timer expires.
- As soon as time goes out, all signs reveal their hidden multipliers, and the gamer wins whatever worth they shot.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the standard Japanese arcade game, Pachinko includes a large wall filled with physical pegs.

- The host drops a puck from the top of the board.
- The puck bounces randomly down the pegs till it lands in among the slots at the bottom, which consists of a multiplier.
- If the puck lands in a **"DOUBLE"** slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again for an even larger payment.

4. Crazy Time

The crown gem of the game. When triggered, the host opens a red door leading into a surreal, brilliantly colored virtual world featuring a massive, 64-segment mega-wheel.

- Players should pick one of three flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The host spins the wheel, and the flapper the gamer selected identifies their reward.
- This wheel includes **"DOUBLE"** and **"TRIPLE"** sections. If the flapper points to one of these, all multipliers on the wheel multiply, and the wheel spins again-- enabling wins to scale as much as the video game's maximum cap of 500,000 x!

Methods for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is eventually a game of chance determined by RNG and physics, gamers typically utilize various wagering techniques to manage their bankroll and optimize their time playing.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:** Betting greatly on the numbers (1 and 2) alongside a little cover bet on the bonus offer rounds. This technique yields regular, smaller wins, keeping the bankroll steady for longer periods.
- **The Bonus-Only Strategy:** Ignoring the numbers completely and placing little bets specifically on the 4 perk rounds (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time). This method is high-risk, high-reward, as it counts on hitting the fairly rare perk segments to see a return.
- **The Spread Strategy:** Placing bets throughout a variety of sectors (numbers and rewards alike) to ensure that a high portion of the wheel yields some kind of return.

Necessary Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed home entertainment budget before visiting and never ever chase losses.
- **Understand Volatility:** Bonus rounds do not hit on every spin. Anticipate droughts while waiting on a reward to trigger.
- **Play for Entertainment:** Remember that live gambling establishment games are developed primarily for fun and entertainment, not as a reliable source of income.
