- **Chroma 2 Case**-- Though still technically available, its initial drop rate was lower than the majority of, and it is thought about "rare" by lots of traders.

3. **In-Game Drops**-- For cases that still periodically drop (e.g., Chroma 2), gamers can increase their opportunities by getting involved in official Valve operations or by using active servers. The drop rate stays low, so persistence is important.
