2. 20% raw protein for the topline racing and sport ask of them

It rates 4.55 from 2 reviews on the product page, and bifid backs the purchase with a 30-Day Money-Back Guarantee and a 24/7 licensed vet team; the store rates 9.0/10 across

24,098 reviews, with the US operation based in Florida. It costs \$52.99 for a 44 lb bag, and the product page carries the full details.

Who this is for: owners retraining or competing a thoroughbred who want a premium feed with the trial risk covered.

How to feed it

Pur.Muskel is a supplementary feed mixed into a complete ration — forage stays the base, and it is never a standalone complete feed. Rates per 220 lb (100 kg) of body weight per day:

Work level Daily rate per 220 lb (100 kg) body weight
Light work 0.07–0.11 lb (30–50 g)
Medium work 0.11–0.18 lb (50–80 g)
Heavy work 0.18–0.22 lb (80–100 g)

Example: a 1,000 lb horse in medium work gets 50–80 g daily. These are modest gram-range rates — weigh the ration rather than scooping on sight, and adjust to condition and the week's work. bifid's feeding calculator works out the daily amount for your horse.

Key specs at a glance: 44 lb bag, \$52.99, raw protein 20%, raw fat 15.0%, starch 5.8%, sugar 4.1% — a supplementary feed added to a complete ration.

Is Pur.Muskel a good fit for thoroughbreds?

Yes — it supports muscle development with 20% raw protein and supplies 14.1 MJ/kg digestible energy while starch is held at 5.8% for a rideable mind. It is added to a complete ration, not fed on its own.

Will it heat up my thoroughbred?

Energy comes from 15.0% raw fat instead of starch, which is held at 5.8% with sugar at 4.1%. The profile is formulated for metabolically sensitive breeds and level heads.
