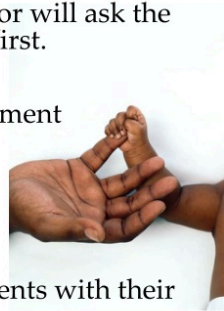




Mediation Process
