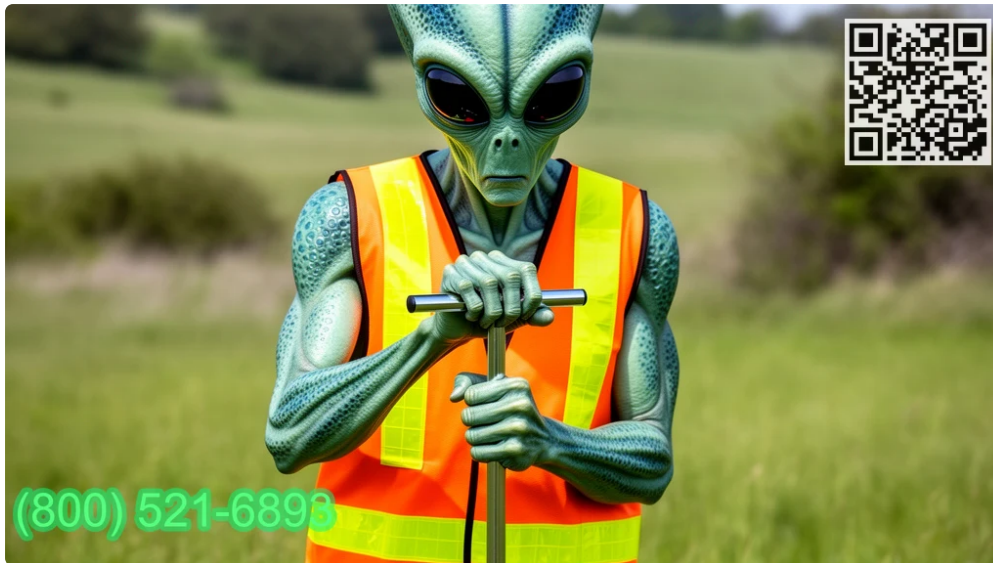
The common tool designs you will certainly run into
