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If you own a home in Arlington, you already know what our climate does to exterior surfaces. One wet spring and a shaded side of your home can begin growing algae. A couple of seasons of pollen and traffic dust will turn a brilliant driveway dull gray. Brick actions get slick. Composite decks collect mildew in the grain.

On hot days, that additional care can be the difference between healthy landscaping and curled brown leaves two days later.

If you have animals or children, ask about dwell times and rinsing.
