Active Ingredient: Hydrogen Peroxide (6%-14% OTC, up to 20% Pro). Breaks down stains via oxidation.



SESSION TIME: 30-60 min.
Move freely.

LIFESTYLE FIT (PROS & CONS)



PROS: Convenient, quick touch-ups, lower upfront cost, less initial sensitivity.



CONS: Incomplete coverage (misses back/spaces), one-size-fits-all, results fade faster.



COST: \$20-\$60 per box. Economical for occasional use.

TEETH WHITENING GEL



HOW IT WORKS:

Thicker formula applied with custom or boil-and-bite tray/brush. Surrounds each tooth completely, reaches crevices.

INGREDIENTS



Active Ingredient: Hydrogen Peroxide (3%-10%) or Carbamide Peroxide (10%-35%). CP releases H2O2 slowly.



SESSION TIME: 30 min to 2 hours (or overnight). Stay relatively still.

LIFESTYLE FIT (PROS & CONS)



PROS: Superior, comprehensive coverage (all teeth), longer-lasting results, more economical long-term (refills).



CONS: Higher upfront cost (trays), more setup time, restricts movement, higher sensitivity risk.



COST: \$80-\$150 upfront (trays), \$15-\$30 refills. Cheaper over time for regular whiteners.

SAFETY & SENSITIVITY



Both safe when used as directed. Sensitivity affects ~60%.

Strips: MILD sensitivity, usually goes away in 24h.



Gel: MODERATE to SEVERE sensitivity with higher concentrations, lasts 2-3 days. Can be managed.
