The truck rolled at 7:15, unloaded by nine:10, and the team assembled two beds and the dining table. Total bill used to be better than a customary weekday move by way of about 18 p.c., normally by using the added hand and a equal-day charge, yet neatly below the hire penalty. No damages, no warmness things beyond just a few added water breaks. The key used to be fair consumption, versatile workforce sizing, and entry that matched the promise.

Red flags that could nonetheless make you walk away

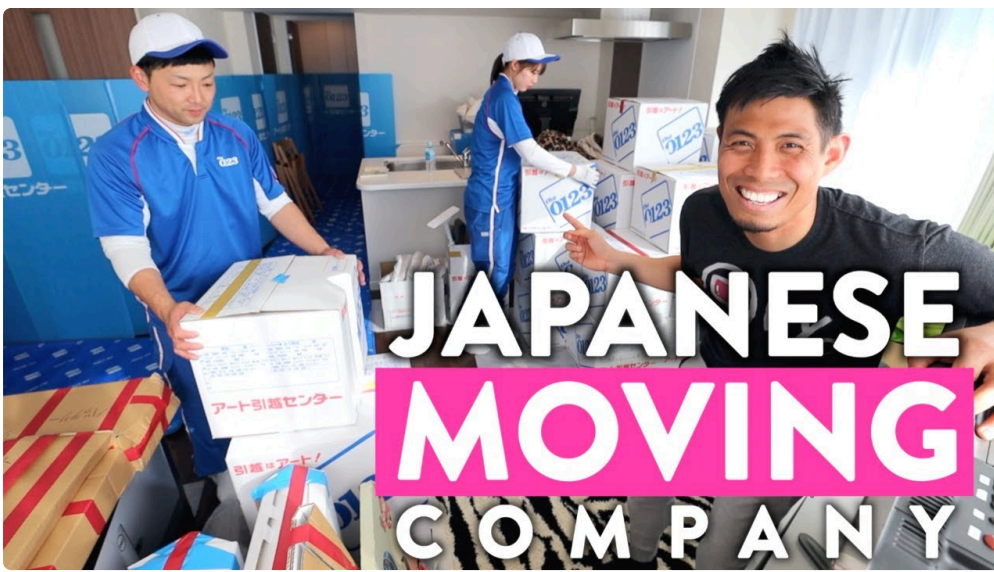
