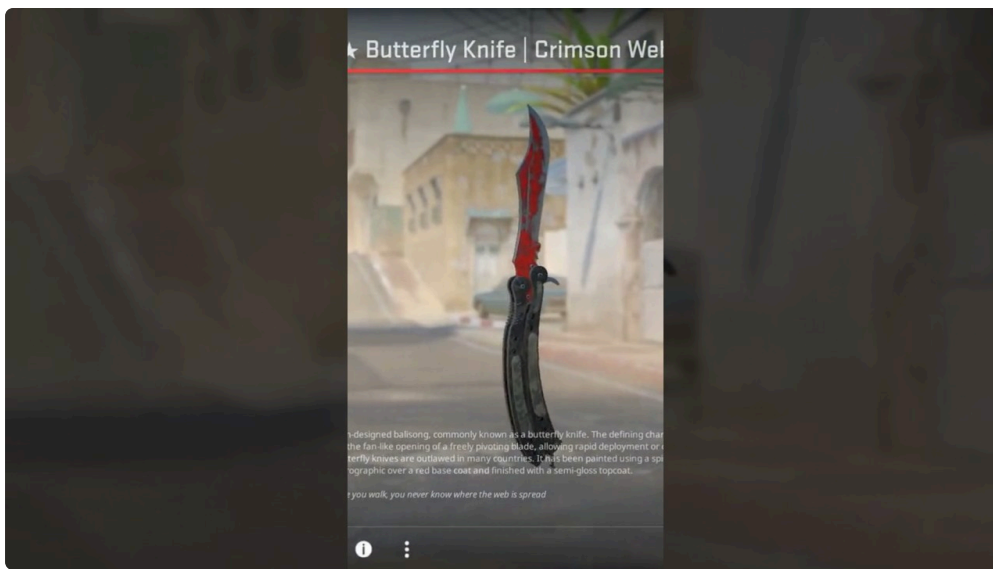
Taking Full Advantage Of Value from Cheap Cases
