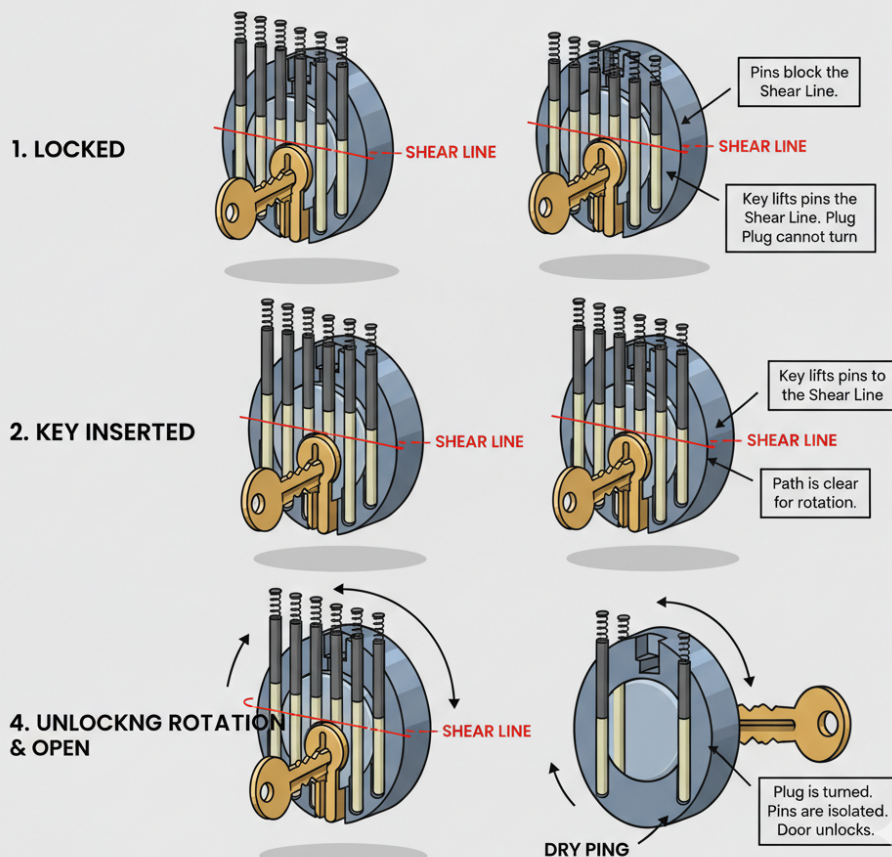
How on-site work solves the problem faster

Why car keys are no longer simple metal blanks
