Storm-Damaged Wood Can Hold Hidden Tension Bent trunks, suspended limbs, lodged branches, and uprooted root plates can store tremendous energy. Cutting the wrong section can cause sudden movement. That is why emergency work often starts with stabilization and an access plan before the crew begins processing debris. Document the Site When storm damage affects a structure or other property, photographs taken from a safe location can be useful before debris is removed. Do not enter an unsafe area just to get a better photo. The removal crew can then explain what must be moved first and what cleanup options are available. Questions to Ask Before Hiring Ask the contractor to explain:- What removal method is planned

- How structures and surrounding property will be protected
- What equipment needs access to the property
- Whether logs, limbs, chips, and brush will be hauled **local tree service near me** away
- Whether stump grinding is included or optional
- How the scope changes if hidden damage or difficult access is discovered
