Metal mesh and chainwire

Mesh fencings are frequently picked for safety and visibility. They can look basic, yet simple is where cautious design matters. If posts are uneven or ground deepness differs, the mesh will droop slightly and the leading line drifts.

Composite or plastic style fences

The fix wasn't extravagant. We reset eviction with careful realignment and inspected the post straightness after the concrete collection. The fencing itself stayed right, and unexpectedly the entire system felt solid.
