

Garage Door Repair Services in Encino and Los Angeles

The **photo-eye sensors** near the floor must face each other and remain free of dirt or obstruction. If they are misaligned, the door may reverse or refuse to close.

A faulty **garage door remote** may need a fresh battery, reprogramming, or replacement. If wall controls work but the remote does not, the issue may be limited to the remote or receiver. If neither control operates the door, the opener, electrical supply, or safety circuit requires further diagnosis.
