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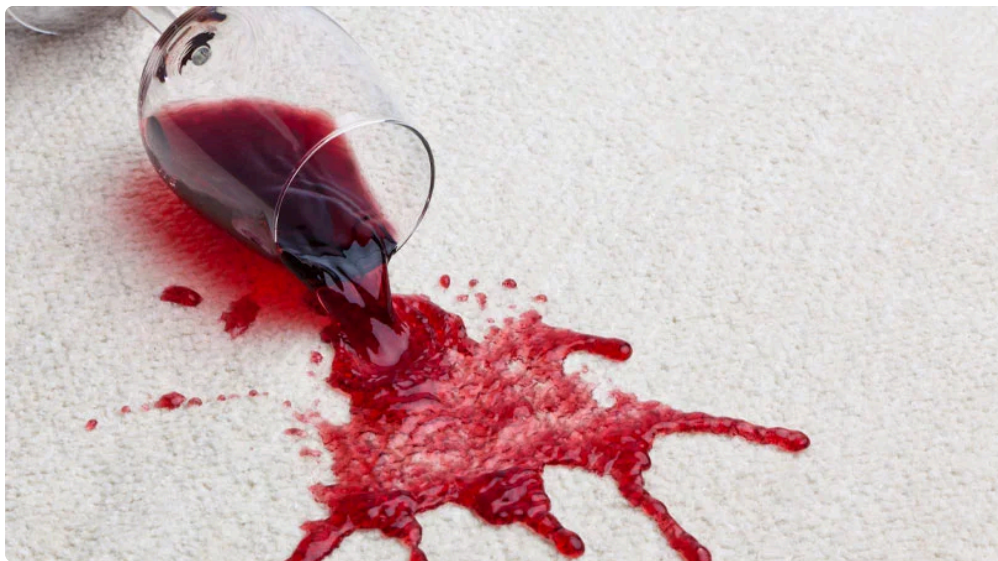

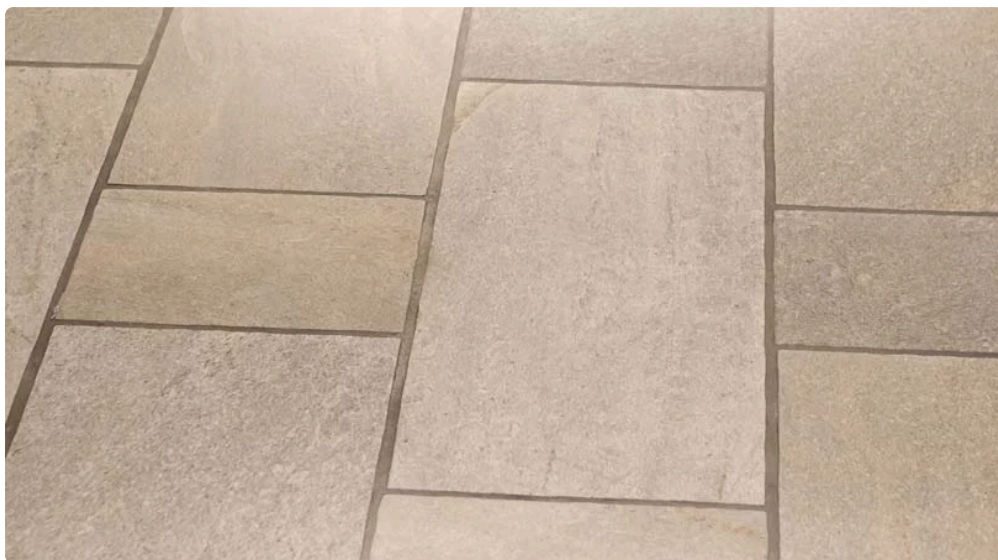

Dry times: four hours isn't a boast, it's a benchmark

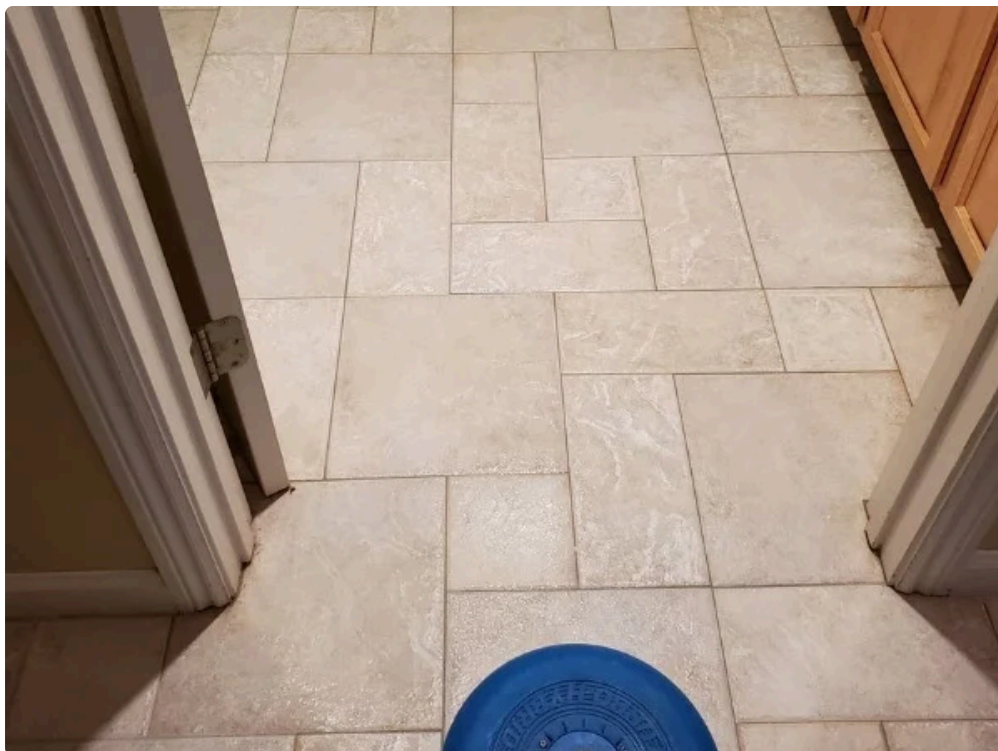
