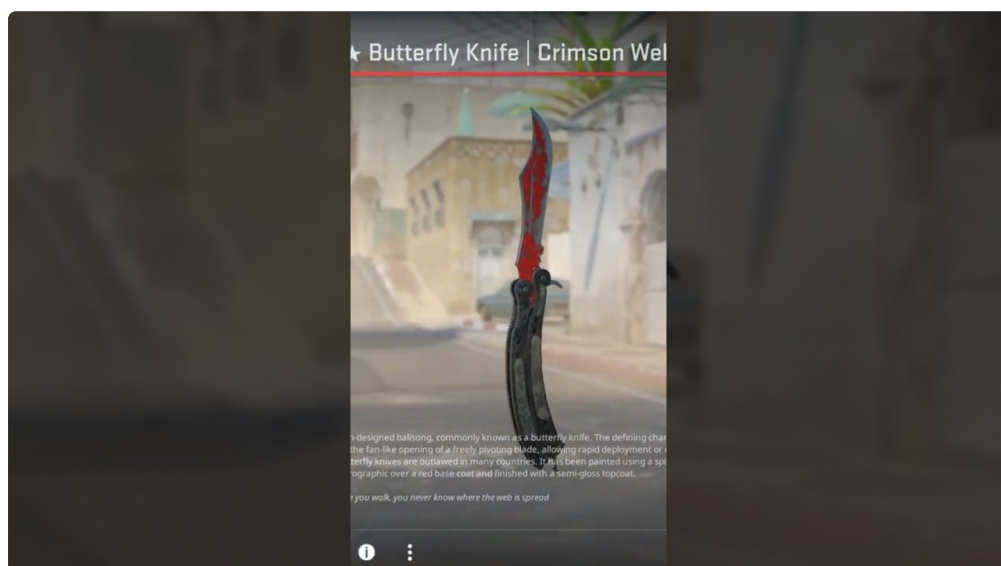

- **Focus on "sticker" cases**-- Some cheap cases include important stickers (e.g., Cologne 2015). Stickers can sometimes go beyond the case cost.
