What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live online casino video game reveal bitz.io hosted by a passionate, real-life speaker. The game is broadcasted from a cutting edge studio equipped with lively, colorful sets that stimulate a carnival or television video game reveal environment.

The focal point of the video game is an enormous, vertically installed wheel consisting of 54 sections. Gamers put bets on where they believe the wheel will stop after a spin. Nevertheless, what sets Crazy Time apart from traditional wheel games-- like Evolution's own *Dream Catcher*-- is the inclusion of a Top Slot multiplier and four distinct, extremely immersive bonus video games.

Understanding the Wheel Segments and Bets

To play Crazy Time effectively, gamers need to initially comprehend the betting design. The 54 sections on the wheel are divided into number bets and bonus game bets. Each segment uses various payment potentials and probabilities.

Number Bets

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payout: 1:1
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payout: 2:1
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payment: 5:1

- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payout: 10:1

Benefit Game Bets

- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel.
- **Cash Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel.

The Top Slot Feature

Before every single spin of the primary wheel, a small two-reel slots located above the primary wheel spins at the same time.

- **How it Works:** The left reel shows among the betting options (numbers or reward games), while the ideal reel displays a multiplier (varying from 2x up to 50x).
- **The Result:** If the sign on the left reel matches the outcome of the primary wheel spin, the multiplier is applied to that win. If it points to a perk game, the multiplier uses to all multipliers inside that particular bonus round.

Diving Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The real magic of the game happens when the wheel lands on among the 4 perk segments. Gamers who have positioned a bet on that particular reward round are carried to a secondary video game screen, where massive multipliers wait for.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the four reward rounds. A coin with a red side and a blue side is turned by a maker. Before the flip, random multipliers are assigned to both sides of the coin. Whichever side lands face up determines the player's payment.

- **Reward function:** If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can in some cases be triggered, offering players another possibility at higher benefits.

2. Money Hunt

Players are provided with a massive interactive screen showing a shooting gallery with 108 random multipliers concealed behind numerous symbols (like a cactus, target, or sheriff's badge).

- **The Gameplay:** Players use a virtual cannon to aim and shoot at one symbol before a countdown timer expires. When the timer ends, all symbols reveal their concealed multipliers, and the gamer is granted the multiplier they strike.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the traditional Japanese arcade game, Pachinko includes a large wall filled with physical pegs.

- **The Gameplay:** The live host drops a puck from the top of the wall. As the puck cascades downward, it bounces arbitrarily off the pegs before landing in one of a number of multiplier zones at the bottom. If the puck lands on a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again.

4. Crazy Time

The supreme bonus offer round. Gamers walk through a red door into a surreal, virtual world including an enormous, 64-segment mega wheel.

- **The Gameplay:** The gamer (or the host, depending on the game variation) chooses one of 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel is spun, and whatever multiplier the picked flapper points to is granted. Like Pachinko, this wheel likewise features "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" segments, permitting lucky players to trigger huge wins up to the game's cap of 20,000 x.

Tips and Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is basically a game of chance determined by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, players often utilize various techniques to handle their bankroll and make the most of home entertainment.

- **The Conservative Approach (Number Betting):**
 - Focus mostly on wagering numbers 1 and 2, that make up a large portion of the wheel. This method yields frequent, smaller wins, keeping the bankroll steady and extending playtime.
- **The Balanced Approach (Covering Bonuses):**
 - Spread small bets throughout all 4 reward rounds while periodically backing number 10. This ensures eligibility for the high-paying perk games without draining pipes funds too quickly.
- **The High-Volatility Approach (Bonus Hunting):**
 - Place bets exclusively on the benefit rounds (Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Crazy Time, Coin Flip). This style needs perseverance and a larger bankroll, as dry spells can occur, however it offers direct access to the game's highest possible payments.

Finest Practices for Responsible Gaming

1. **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed total up to invest before starting the video game and never chase losses.
2. **Understand the RTP:** Keep in mind that bonus bets typically have a somewhat lower RTP than easy number bets, meaning they are higher threat, higher benefit.
3. **Enjoy the Show:** Treat the betting cost as the cost of admission to an interactive video game program. The main objective needs to constantly be entertainment.
