Another buyer cooks everyday and keeps cast iron on the circulate. We went with rift white all rightfor the island, grain stuffed, then sprayed a 2K waterborne poly in satin. The perimeter cabinets had been painted in a gentle gray waterborne alkyd. The island takes abuse, wipes easy, and exhibits no cup jewelry. The painted perimeter appears warm and has survived a dozen excursion dinners with most effective one small chip in which a stand mixer met a drawer entrance.

Then there was the small urban kitchen wherein the proprietor dreamed of a deep blue, almost black, brush-stroked seem on custom cupboards.
