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Understanding the Betting Layout

Before the wheel spins, gamers have a minimal window to place their chips on the betting grid. The grid includes eight distinct betting alternatives, divided uniformly in between standard numbers and perk triggers.

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payout: 1:1.
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payment: 2:1.
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payout: 5:1.
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payout: 10:1.
- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Triggers the Coin Flip perk.
- **Cash Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel. Activates the Cash Hunt benefit.
- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel. Sets off the Pachinko benefit.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel. Activates the supreme bonus offer round.

The Top Slot Feature: Amplifying the Action

Adding a layer of standard slot mechanics to the game, each and every single spin of the primary wheel is accompanied by a **Top Slot** positioned straight above the presenter and the wheel.



The Top Slot includes two reels that spin all at once:

1. **Reel 1:** Displays a betting area (a number or a bonus offer round).
2. **Reel 2:** Displays a multiplier value (ranging from 2x as much as 50x).

If the horizontal line in the Top Slot connects a betting spot with a multiplier, that multiplier is used to the result of the primary wheel spin, provided the wheel arrive at that specific spot. If a reward round is multiplied, all prizes inside that benefit round are increased accordingly, causing the video game's legendary massive payouts.

Deep Dive: The Four Bonus Rounds

1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 sectors on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** A simple red and blue coin is turned by a mechanical flipper.
- **Payment:** Before the flip, random multipliers are designated to both the red and blue sides of the coin. Whichever side lands face up determines the player's multiplier win.

2. Cash Hunt

- **Frequency:** 2 sections on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** A massive screen displays 108 random multipliers hidden behind shooting gallery targets (symbols like a cactus, target, hat, etc).
- **Payout:** Players use an on-screen cannon to aim and contend a target of their option before time goes out, revealing the hidden multiplier below.

3. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 sections on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** Inspired by the standard Japanese arcade game, a radiant puck is dropped from the top of a huge wall filled with pegs.
- **Payout:** The puck bounces down the board till it lands in a multiplier slot at the bottom. If it hits a "DOUBLE" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 section on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** Players pass through a red door into a virtual, psychedelic world including an enormous giant wheel.

- **Payout:** Players select among 3 flippers (green, blue, or yellow). The presenter presses a big red button to spin the huge wheel. It can yield multipliers approximately 20,000 x if "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" segments are hit along the way.

Strategies for Playing the Crazy Time Slot
