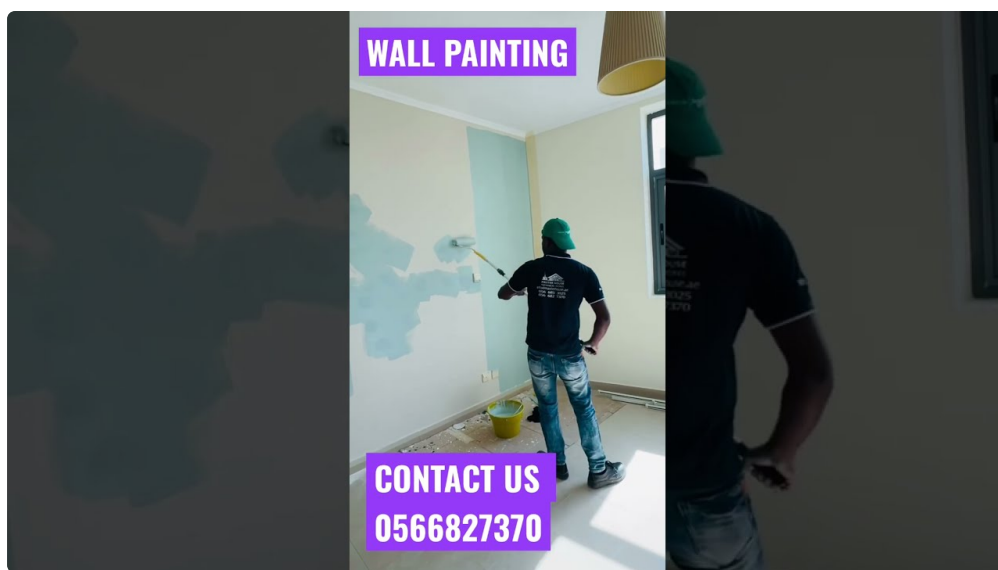

Hardware holes have been crammed and re-drilled to replace from 3-inch pulls to 5-inch, which required a jig and endurance to retailer strains immediately.

From arrival to ultimate wipe-down took 8 running days. At day 3 after rehang, the finish felt dry yet we nevertheless instructed delicate use for about a weeks.
