- Traditional solvent alkyds and oils. The perimeter shelves had been painted in a delicate grey waterborne alkyd. The island takes abuse, wipes sparkling, and suggests no cup jewelry. The painted perimeter seems warm and has survived a dozen trip dinners with in simple terms one small chip where a stand mixer met a drawer the front.

Then there has been the small metropolis kitchen where the owner dreamed of a deep blue, close to black, brush-stroked seem to be on tradition cabinets.
