2. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli System)

If the basic Martingale is too demanding, the Reverse Martingale concentrates on capitalizing on winning streaks while keeping losses minimal.



- **How it works:** You double your bet after every **win**, and reset to your base bet after every **loss**.
- **Objective:** Ride a hot streak of 3 to 4 wins in a row, then squander and reset. This secures your core balance while letting your home's cash trip during a streak.

3. The Low Multiplier Auto-Cashout Strategy (Conservative)

This technique focuses on consistency and durability over massive, life-altering payments.

- **How it works:** You set an **Auto-Cashout** at a really conservative multiplier, usually in between **1.15 x and 1.30 x**.
- **Pros:** The statistical possibility of a crash taking place listed below 1.20 x is fairly low compared to greater multipliers, indicating you will win the large majority of your rounds.
- **Cons:** Because the multiplier is low, a single 1.00 x instantaneous crash can clean out the earnings built up from 10 or 15 effective rounds.
