

Why interprovincial pest services matters in the Ottawa Gatineau area

The Ottawa-Gatineau region is unusual compared with many Canadian metro areas because two provinces share one day-to-day service market. Ottawa, ON and Gatineau, QC sit on opposite sides of the Ottawa River, but homeowners and property managers often compare the same companies when searching for **pest control near me**.
