

Garage Door Repair for Insulated two-vehicle Doors

An insulated garage door can make a noticeable difference in the comfort, quietness, and security of a Los Angeles home. A two-car garage door is wider and heavier than a single-car door, so its springs, cables, rollers, tracks, hinges, and opener must function properly as a system. Even a small alignment problem can place additional strain on the entire overhead garage door system.
