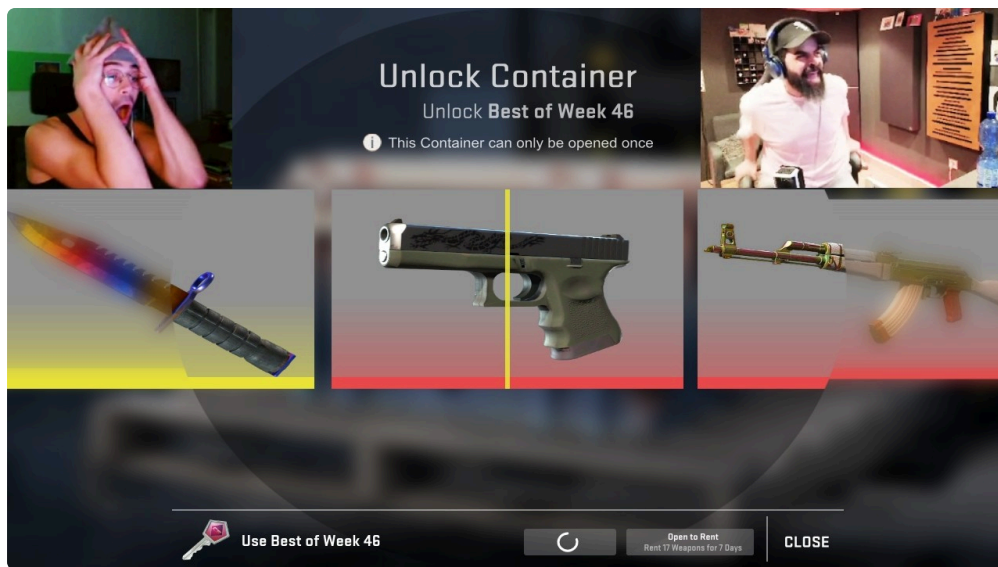
Making The Most Of Value from Cheap Cases
