

How Los Angeles Weather Impacts Garage Doors

Los Angeles, California, has a Mediterranean climate with mild, relatively wet winters and warm, dry summers. Although the weather is generally agreeable for homeowners, repeated sun exposure, temperature changes, wind, and coastal air can gradually affect an overhead garage door and its operating hardware.

Seasonal temperature changes can cause metal components to expand and contract. **Garage Door Opener** Over time, this movement may contribute to loosened fasteners, squeaky garage door tracks, worn garage door rollers, and stress on garage door cables. Hot, dry conditions can also make lubricants less efficient, so regular garage door maintenance is useful even when the door appears to be working normally.
