Service may cover an overhead garage door inspection, realignment of hinges and rollers, replacement of a damaged garage door panel, or diagnostics for a garage door opener. Technicians should also evaluate balance, movement, reversing action, and garage door safety sensors before ending the visit.

- **Garage door track problems:** Bent tracks, loose fasteners, or poor alignment can cause grinding, jerky movement, or rollers that leave the track.
- **Damaged rollers and cables:** Noisy operation, uneven movement, or visible fraying can signal the need for garage door roller replacement or garage door cable repair.

Do not force a stuck door or attempt to remove a spring under tension. These components can store significant energy. A licensed garage door technician has the tools and training to isolate the problem safely.

When You Need Garage Door Spring Replacement

Garage door spring replacement is one of the most frequently requested repairs in Woodland Hills. Springs offset the weight of the door so the opener does not have to lift the full load. If a spring breaks, the door may become too heavy for manual operation and continuing to use the opener can cause more damage.

Most residential systems use either a **torsion spring** mounted above the door or one or more **stretch spring** assemblies positioned alongside the horizontal tracks. The correct replacement depends on the door's weight, height, track configuration, and hardware. A qualified technician should replace springs as a matched set when appropriate and inspect cables, drums, bearings, and brackets at the same time.

If the remote works but the wall switch does not, or if the wall switch works while the remote fails, the issue may involve remote programming, wiring, or the control board.

Dirty or misaligned garage door safety sensors can also prevent the door from closing. These small devices are usually positioned near the bottom of the tracks. They must be aimed at each other and have a direct line of sight. Never bypass them; they are a key part of the opener's safety system.

Garage door opener installation may be worthwhile when an older motor is making excessive noise, lacks modern safety features, or cannot handle the door's weight. The garage door opener installation cost depends on motor strength, drive type, available ceiling height, required electrical work, remotes, keypad controls, and the condition of the existing door. A technician should verify that the door is balanced before installing a replacement opener.

Panel replacement can be a good choice when one section of a sectional garage door is bent, split, or badly dented. Finding a matching replacement panel may be easier for newer doors with available manufacturer parts. Color, window design, insulation, texture, and panel dimensions all need to match.

Repairing or replacing one panel may be more affordable than a full door, but the replacement may not completely match an older door that has discolored in the sun. 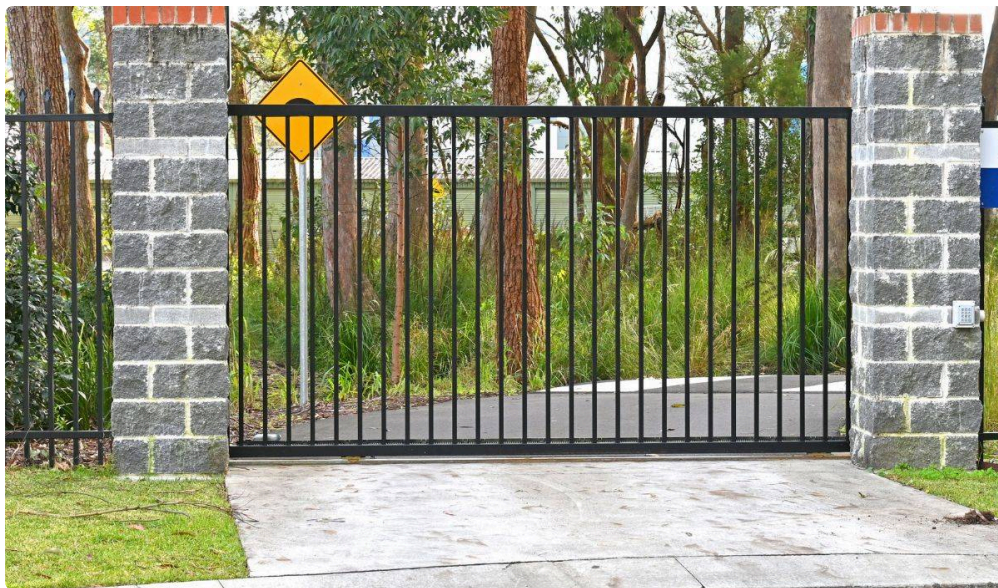
Local Los Angeles Communities We Serve
