We offered two mockups at scale, one with purple face lit letters over a deeper inexperienced panel, and one with white letters and a red accent bar. The group chose the white letters. Seasonal accents lived on customized banners and window vinyl, whereas the storefront indications kept their all-season legibility. The numbers supported the alternative.
