

Most washers last 10–14 years and dryers 10–13 years, but understanding which specific component has failed is what actually determines whether your appliance can be repaired or has reached end of life. How Do You Know Which Part Inside Your Washer or Dryer Has Failed?

What Do Failed Drum and Drive Components Mean for Your Appliance's Future?

The drum, belt, and drive motor are the core moving parts of any washer or dryer. When the drum bearing fails in a washer, you'll hear grinding or thumping during the spin cycle. When a dryer belt snaps, the drum stops turning completely. These are mechanical failures that happen as the appliance ages—friction and wear over thousands of cycles eventually take their toll.

What matters for you is that drum and belt failures are repairable on most models, even older ones. A replacement drum bearing or belt on a 10-year-old machine is often far cheaper than buying new. But if the drum itself is cracked or the motor has failed electrically, those repairs become harder to justify economically. A broken door seal on a front-load washer causes leaking around the base; a failed inlet valve prevents water from entering the tub at all. Drain pump failures mean water won't empty. These parts fail because they're under constant stress, exposed to mineral deposits, and subject to Sacramento's hard water conditions.

A washing machine with a failed drain pump at age 11 is still repairable—pumps are replaceable components designed to wear out. What you need to know is that a failed seal or valve doesn't mean the washer is dead; it means one specific part stopped doing its job. How Do Heating Element and Thermal Component Failures Show Up in Dryers?

A dryer that runs but produces no heat has failed in one of two ways: the heating element burned out, or the thermal fuse melted. Both are common failures around year 10–12 of a dryer's life. The heating element is a coil that gets hot; the thermal fuse is a one-time safety device that blows if the dryer gets too hot. When either fails, your clothes come out cold and damp.

This is important for you to understand: a heating element replacement is straightforward and affordable. A thermal fuse replacement costs almost nothing. But if the dryer won't heat because of a failed blower wheel or clogged vent ductwork, the diagnosis changes the whole picture. That's why component identification matters so much. What Does Electrical Control Failure Tell You About Repair Viability?

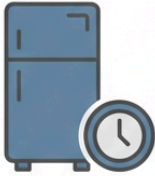
Electronic control boards, timers, and door latches are failure points that often scare homeowners. When a washer or dryer won't start despite power and water, the control board or door latch is often the culprit. These parts fail because of power surges, age-related component degradation, and moisture exposure. A failed door latch on a 10-year-old machine is cheap to replace. A failed control board can be pricier—but still repairable.

Here's what matters: control board failure doesn't automatically mean the appliance is worthless. It means one electrical component stopped working.
