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Walk through any Arlington neighborhood in April and you see the same story on a lot of houses: green movie creeping up siding, dark stripes on gutters, streaks on the driveway, and brick actions that get slick after a rain. The mix of humidity, tree cover, pollen, and road salt in Northern Virginia is rough on outside surface areas. An excellent professional can make a home look 5 years more youthful in an afternoon. A bad one can etch your brick, scar your deck, or void your roof warranty simply as fast.

On older brick rowhouses or painted masonry near Lyon Town or Aurora Highlands, an experienced pro will call the pressure method down and focus on chemistry and dwell time. High pressure on old mortar can accelerate collapsing and leave wand marks that end up being apparent once the wall dries.



Roof washing

Roof cleaning is where the gap between professionals and "guy with a device" ends up being stark.

Asphalt shingle roofings with black streaks are exceptionally common in Arlington. Those streaks are usually a kind of algae referred to as *Gloeocapsa magma*. The appropriate method to resolve them is a soft wash utilizing a very low-pressure application of a service primarily based upon sodium hypochlorite (similar to home bleach, but more powerful and carefully combined), plus surfactants, followed by a thorough rinse where appropriate.
