5. **Pattern/Seed**-- Certain "Blue Gems" or uncommon pattern indexes can command astronomically high prices due to their visual diversity.

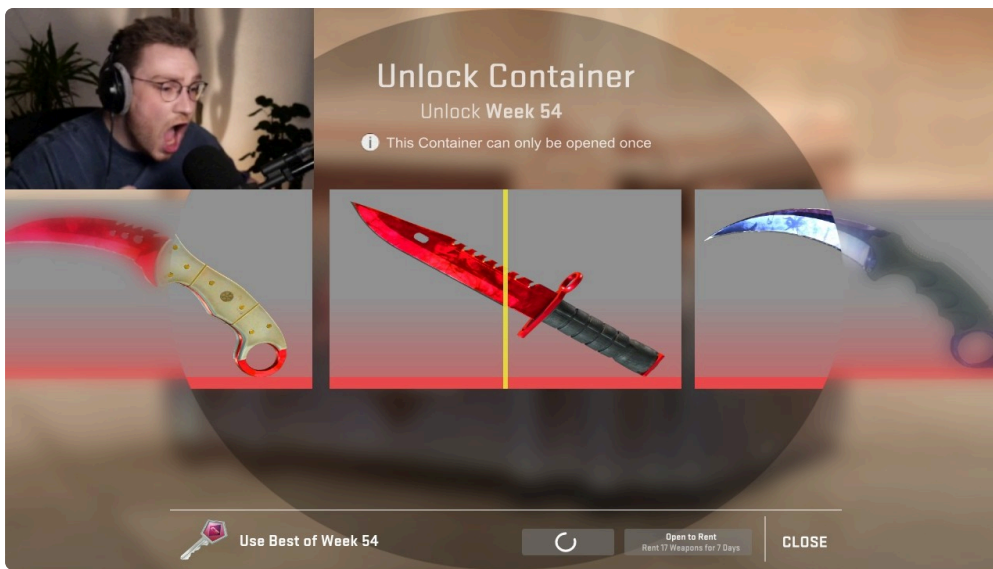
Comprehending these components helps collectors assess the real value of an uncommon skin.

Market Overview

The CS2 skin market runs on Steam's community market and third-party trading platforms. Costs are driven by:

- **Supply vs. Demand**-- Low supply combined with high demand (e.g., from expert gamers or influencers) inflates costs.
- **Condition**-- Factory-new (FN) items bring a premium; very little wear (MW) and field-tested (FEET) are more affordable but still desirable.
- **Economic Factors**-- Seasonal sales, new case releases, and changes in cryptocurrency worths can sway market patterns.

Due to the fact that the market is mostly player-driven, rates can be unstable. Remaining informed about recent trades, case openings, and competition events is important for any major collector.
