4. Coinflip

A timeless 1v1 game of opportunity. 2 players wager skins of approximately equal worth. The system designates one player as Heads and the other as Tails, then flips a virtual coin. The winner takes the entire pot, minus a small platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the expert scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match betting is the go-to alternative. Users wager on professional groups utilizing odds computed by the platform, similar to conventional sportsbooks.
