## What is Crazy Time?

At its core, *Crazy Time* is a live dealership video game reveal hosted by a passionate, energetic presenter. The focal point of the game is a massive, vertically installed wheel containing 54 sectors. Players put bets on the sector they believe the wheel will stop on.

While the concept sounds easy, the combination of a **Top Slot**-- a secondary two-reel slots that spins at the same time with the main wheel-- injects random multipliers into each and every single round. If the Top Slot aligns a bet type with a multiplier, every win related to that bet is significantly boosted.

## The Wheel Breakdown

To comprehend how the game works, one should take a look at the design of the 54 sections. The wheel is divided into numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) and 4 bonus round sectors.

As seen in the table above, the lower numbers appear most often, while the lucrative bonus rounds are much rarer, including high-volatility excitement to the gameplay.

## The Four Wild and Wonderful Bonus Rounds

The real magic of *Crazy Time* depend on its 4 benefit games. Triggering one of these rounds transfers players from the main studio into immersive, interactive augmented reality mini-games.

### 1. Coin Flip

This is the simplest and most regular reward round.

- **How it works:** A coin with a red side and a blue side is turned by a mechanical flipper.
- **The Payout:** Before the flip, random multipliers are designated to both the red and blue sides. Whichever side lands deal with up figures out the multiplier used to the player's stake.

### 2. Cash Hunt

Step up to an enormous virtual shooting gallery.

- **How it works:** The screen shows a grid of 108 random multipliers concealed behind different symbols (like a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).
- **The Payout:** Players use an on-screen cannon to aim and contend one symbol before a countdown timer expires. Once the timer ends, all symbols reveal their surprise multipliers, and the player wins whatever value their selected symbol concealed.

### 3. Pachinko

Motivated by the traditional Japanese arcade video game, Pachinko is everything about gravity and anticipation.

- **How it works:** The dealer drops a puck from the top of a glowing purple Pachinko wall filled with physical pegs. The puck bounces randomly down the board till it lands in one of the landing zones at the bottom.
- **The Payout:** Each zone consists of a multiplier. If the puck lands in a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again for huge potential payments.

### 4. Crazy Time

The supreme feature of the video game, taking location behind an enormous red door.

- **How it works:** The host opens the door to expose a surreal, huge virtual wheel with 64 sections and 3 flippers (Green, Blue, and Yellow).
- **The Payout:** The player must choose one of the three flippers. The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the chosen flipper points to when the wheel stops is granted to the gamer. Simply like Pachinko, landing on "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" increases all worths on the wheel for a re-spin.

Since these inhabit most of the wheel, players experience more regular, smaller wins, enabling them to sustain longer play sessions and increase their opportunities of casually backing into a reward round.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:** Placing small wagers solely on the 4 bonus offer sections (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time). This technique accepts regular losses on base numbers in exchange for direct

participation whenever a reward round is set off.

- **Covering the Board:** Some gamers select to spread out little bets across numerous numbers and benefit rounds to ensure they have a stake in almost every spin. However, this requires mindful bankroll management, as covering too lots of results can rapidly deplete funds if low-paying numbers keep hitting.

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed amount you want to invest before you begin playing, and never chase losses.
- **Comprehend the RTP:** Remember that benefit rounds offer high volatility. They can yield massive wins, however they do not struck on every spin.
