Key Rules to Look for in Live Casinos

- **Blackjack Payouts:** Always look for tables that pay **3:2** for a natural blackjack. Avoid tables that pay **6:5**, as this significantly increases the house benefit.
- **Dealer Soft 17 Rule:** Check whether the dealer must strike or stand on a soft 17 (an Ace and a 6). A dealership standing on soft 17 is more beneficial to the player.
- **Double Down Restrictions:** Some tables restrict doubling down to hard totals of 10 and 11 only, while others enable doubling on any 2 cards. The latter is always much better for the gamer.
- **Splitting Rules:** Look for tables that enable players to divide pair to 3 or 4 times (resulting in numerous hands) and those that permit doubling down after splitting (DAS).
