## CS: GO Cases: A Comprehensive Guide for the Modern Player \*\*

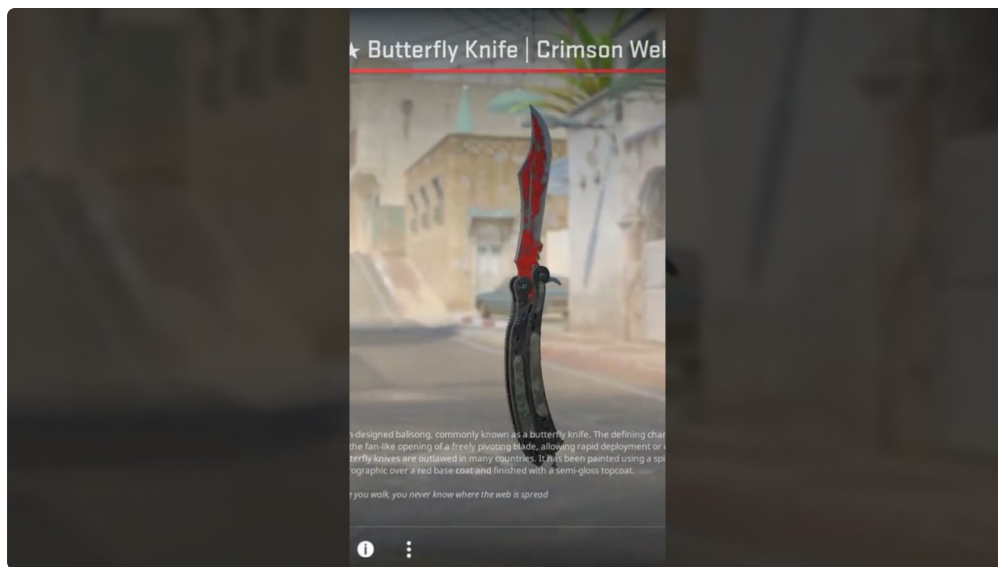
Notes:

- The "Covert" rarity is the rarest tier and constantly looks like the benefit item (knife or gloves).
- The percentages shown are approximate and can shift slightly with each case patch.
- Prices on the Steam Market often exceed the in-game cost for highly sought-after skins.

## 3. Why These Cases Matter

### 3.1 Economy Influence

When a new case launches, the market responds within hours. The **Recoil Case**, for instance, drove the price of the *SCAR-20|Plan* (Mil-Spec) from £ 0.15 to £ 0.45 on the very first day. On the other hand, older cases like **Prisma** often see a price dip as supply stabilises.



### 3.2 Aesthetic Variety

Each case introduces a distinct visual style. The **Revolution Case** leans into vibrant, graffiti-style art work, while the **Recoil Case** embraces a more commercial, military-tech aesthetic. Players who gather themed loadouts can curate their stock around these releases.

### 3.3 Odds and Value
