On heavy profiles with again beveled edges, we undercut by a hair to prevent caulk lines invisible. Between coats, a speedy cross with a fantastic grit sanding sponge eliminates filth nibs and stands the fibers down, primarily on waterborne approaches that boost grain just a little.

Dry times are usually not assistance. A waterborne teeth that feels dry to touch after two hours also can nonetheless be soft. Sanding or taping too early can mar the movie.
