- **Money Hunt:** Appears 2 times. A shooting gallery screen with 108 random multipliers hidden behind signs. Players objective and shoot to expose their reward.
- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times. A radiant wall filled with pegs. A puck is dropped, and wherever it lands figures out the final multiplier.
